It was moved by Wright, seconded by Wilkie, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Wing, that the Meeting recess until next Tuesday night at 8 P.M., June 9<sup>th</sup>, 1936. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Crowley and Wright; Motion carried.
