

MAY 15, 1936

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held May 15th, 1936.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Evans; Absent: Ewart, Crowley, Wright; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Application for building permit No. 1344 signed by Ralph Crowley was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Evans, that the permit be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Ewart, Crowley, Evans; Motion carried.

Bill of Sale covering one 1935-V8 Ford Sedan, Motor No. 11706291, traded in to Bonneville Auto Company for \$426.00 on new Ford was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Bill of Sale. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

when those places were searched for intoxicating liquors on the 12th instant, we recommend that these three proprietors be cited to appear and show cause before the Mayor and City Council, at our next regular Meeting, on June 5, 1936, if any they have, why their respective Beer Licenses should not be revoked.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Crabtree, that the City Attorney prepare, and have served, notice and order to the above named parties. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Gourley, that Elmer C. Rigby be given until June 5th, 1936, to appear before the Council to answer notice and order served on him under date of April 20th, 1936. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Ewart, Crowley and Wright; Motion carried.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Evans, that Frank Munsee be hired as a regular Fireman, as provided for in the 1936-37 Budget which increases the regular Firemen to nine men. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Crowley, Wright, Ewart; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wilkie, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase a carload of pipe for the Water Department. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Wright, Ewart, Crowley; Motion carried.

The following applications for Beer Licenses were read: Hotel Bonneville, Sewell's United Stores, and Roy Fullerwider. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Evans, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wing, that the J. O. Weaver Fox Farm be allowed to connect on to the waterline in the south side of the City Park at its own expense. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Evans; Absent: Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Gourley, that water extension be put in for Howard Larsen on Canyon Street to Lot 33 in Block 63, Highland Park Addition, if he will dig the trench. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Evans; Absent: Crowley, Wright, Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wing, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.
