It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Crabtree, that the bills for the month of October, 1935, in the sum of \$18,359.94, be allowed and warrants be drawn on the proper funds in payment of same. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.

Auto Parts Company presented their bid of \$29.31 for portions of Lots 3-4-5-6- and 7 in Block 8 of Dwight's Addition which were advertised for sale. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wing, that the bid of Auto Parts Company of \$29.31 for portions of Lots 3-4-5-6 and 7 in Block 8 of Dwight's Addition to the City of Idaho Falls be accepted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.

City Electrician, Goudy, stated that the current transformers which were purchased for the tank heater control system were too small and these can be turned in on larger transformers for credit. The difference between the two sizes of transformers would be about \$603.00. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase the new transformers at a difference of about \$603.00 in addition to the old transformers turned in. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.

Councilman Wright stated that the truck now being used to haul supplies for construction work at the Upper Power House was worn out and the Finance Committee requests authority to purchase a new truck. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the Finance Committee be authorized to purchase a utility truck for use in hauling material to the Upper Power Plant. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.

Councilman Ewart stated that all of the loose rock in the tail race at the Upper Power House should be moved out before the new unit is installed, and a drag line can be rented from the Butte & Market Lake Canal Company for about \$15.00 per day. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Evans, that the City Electrician and City Attorney make arrangements with the Butte & Market Lake Canal Company to rent their drag line. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.
