Also to consider the purchasing of the ten acres west of the cemetery owned by John M. Shearer for an addition to Rosehill Cemetery.

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, Barzilla W. Clark, to file an application to the United States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for a grant only to aid in financing the construction of Special Improvement Paving District and designating C. R. Black, City Engineer, to furnish such information as the Government may request was read. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Evans, that the Resolution be adopted. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Crowley and Wilkie; Motion carried.

Councilman Wright stated that the Shearer property west of the cemetery could be purchased for \$7500.00 at the present time with about \$500.00 down payment. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Crabtree, that the matter be referred to the Finance Committee with power to act. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Crowley and Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wright, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley and Wilkie; Motion carried.
