It was moved by Wright, seconded by Evans, that the bills for the month of August, 1935, in the sum of \$23,384.91 be allowed, and warrants be drawn on the proper funds in payment of same. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Crabtree, Ewart and Crowley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Gourley, that enough logs be purchased to complete the hangars at the Municipal Airport. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Wing, Gourley, Wright; Absent: Crabtree, Ewart, and Crowley; Motion carried.

W. L. Shattuck presented a map showing Rollandet Avenue and stated that this Avenue should be moved from its present location to where it belongs. The Mayor referred same to the Street and Alley Committee.

Councilman Wright stated that the Legion and Chamber of Commerce wanted to hold a four day race meet at the City Park next week, September 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, and 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1935. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Wilkie, that the matter be turned over to the Fourth of July Committee to handle. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Crabtree, Ewart and Crowley; Motion carried. Councilman Wright resigned from the Fourth of July Committee. The Mayor appointed Councilman Gourley to replace Councilman Wright on this Committee.

It was moved and seconded that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Ewart, Crowley, and Crabtree; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 20<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1935.
