

SEPTEMBER 6, 1935

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 6th, 1935.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: None; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting and Special Meeting were read and approved.

All protests were opened and read which were filed against the proposed paving district, as follows:

Property owners present at said Meeting presented their protests. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wilkie, that the proposed paving of Short Street adjoining Lots 15 to 28, both inclusive, in Block 18, Winn's Addition, and Lots 8 to 14, both inclusive, in Block 20, Winn's Addition, and the North Half of Eagle Rock School property, Block 20, Winn's Addition, be eliminated from the proposed Special Improvement District No. 17. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wright, that the City proceed with the work of improving the streets as set forth in the Resolution of Intention to create Local Improvement District No. 17, (except Short Street adjoining Lots 15 to 28, both inclusive, in Block 18, Winn's Addition, and Lots 8 to 14, both inclusive in Block 20, Winn's Addition, and North Half of Eagle Rock School property, Block 20, Winn's Addition, and that Resolution be ratified and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Motion carried.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Water Works Superintendent, Sanitary Inspector, Chief of Fire Department, Street and Park Commissioner.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Gourley, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

Dr. H. B. Woolley addressed the Council in regard to employing a school nurse. He stated that the nurse's salary would be \$125.00 per month and the School District would pay \$75.00 each month, if the City would pay \$50.00 each month. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Gourley, that the City pay \$50.00 per month on the nurse's salary. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried. Dr. Woolley advised the Council that the following committee would have charge of the nurse in regard to her work at the schools and in the City: Superintendent of Schools, President of the P. T. A., and City Physician. The Mayor then gave the City Physician authority to appoint the nurse.

The following applications for Beer Licenses were read: Elmer C. Rigby, Josie Russell, Florence Winchester. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

John Nielsen, owner of the Rock House on Eagle Rock Street, requested the Council to reconsider the application for Beer License which was rejected on August 16th, 1935. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wing, that the application for license to Retail Beer signed by Laura Williams for the Rock House on Eagle Rock Street be reconsidered. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Wright: Pass; Motion carried.

It was moved and seconded that the Meeting recess until next Thursday, at 8 P.M. September 10th, 1935. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 20th day of September, 1935.
