It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Crabtree, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

A letter from D. G. Sautter, Chairman of the Examining Board of Plumbers was read. After considerable discussion it was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wright, that the letter be referred to the City Attorney and Plumbing Inspector. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO BUY, RECEIVE OR ACCEPT ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY FROM A MINOR UNLESS THE MINOR IS ACCOMPANIED BY HIS LEGAL GUARDIAN OR ONE OF HIS PARENTS AT THE TIME OF THE PURCHASE: AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and that the Ordinance be placed on its second, third and final readings. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Wright, seconded by Crowley, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Gourley, seconded by Evans, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading and be adopted, passed and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 476 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

After considerable discussion of House Bill No. 87 by Harry L. Mooney, Secretary of the Idaho Falls Insurance Association and the Councilmen, it was moved by Crowley, seconded by Evans, that we go on record as protesting the passage of House Bill No. 87 in its present form. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Gourley; Nay: Wilkie and Ewart; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wright, that the Meeting recess until next Friday, February 8th, 1935. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 15th day of February, 1935.
