It was moved by Wright, seconded by Gourley, that the bills for the month of December, 1934, in the amount of \$19,763.53 be allowed and warrants be drawn on the proper funds in payment of same. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Ewart, and Gourley; Absent: Wilkie and Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

Application for Building Permit No. 1121 signed by Gus Roos was read. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the permit be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Absent: Wilkie and Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING THE SOUTHEASTERLY EIGHT FEET OF COTTAGE AVENUE IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO, EXTENDING SOUTHWESTERLY FROM THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE, PRODUCED SOUTHEASTERLY, OF BROADWAY STREET IN SAID CITY TO THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE, PRODUCED SOUTHEASTERLY, OF MARKET STREET IN SAID CITY, TO THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OREGON SHORT LINE RAILROAD COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Absent:

Wilkie and Mehlhoff; Motion carried. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and JANUARY 10, 1935

that the Ordinance be placed on its second, third and final reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, and Evans; Absent: Wilkie and Mehlhoff; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Wright, seconded by Evans, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Absent: Mehlhoff, Wilkie; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading and be adopted, passed and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 475 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The Mayor stated that the sewer on G Street would not take care of the runoff from the railroad filtering plant and they should connect on to the storm sewer. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company connect their water filtering plant on to the storm sewer. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree; Motion carried.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Wright, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Ewart; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 18th day of January, 1935.
