

JANUARY 4, 1935

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held January 4th, 1935.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Absent: None; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of previous Meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, Police Judge, City Electrician, Sanitary Inspector, Street & Park Commissioner, Water Master, Chief of Fire Department.

Lavern T. Clark, City Treasurer of St. Anthony, Idaho, offered to sell the City water meters which would cost \$7.35 each and he stated they could be installed for about \$4.00 each. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the proposition be referred to the Light & Water Committee to report back to the Council. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Motion carried.

Application for electric line extension to Lots 1 to 12 and Lots 17-18-19-20 in Block 71, Highland Park Addition, signed by James and Mark Streeter was read. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light & Water Committee.

Application for building permit No. 1120 signed by M & K Co., Inc. was read. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Wilkie, that the permit be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

A letter from Alvin Denman regarding a shack near the intersection of Pine, Placer and Thirteenth Street was read. The Mayor referred same to the Street and Ditch Committee.

City Attorney, Ralph Albaugh, stated that the trespass suit filed against the City by S. W. Dennis last year could be settled out of court for \$75.00 and he would advise the City to accept the settlement. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the compromise settlement for \$75.00 be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting recess until next Thursday, January 10th, 1935, at 8 P.M. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Motion carried.
