

JULY 5, 1935

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held July 5th, 1935.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Absent: None; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

Thereupon the City Clerk presented an affidavit of publishing the notice of the Refunding Bonds of said City of Idaho Falls, such affidavit showing that said notice has been duly published in compliance with the order of the Council heretofore entered. The Council then considered all sealed proposals to purchase said Refunding Bonds and it appearing that the proposal of Edward L. Burton & Company, bid and most responsible bid for said bonds and a sum greater than par and accrued interest, it was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that the Refunding Bonds of said City in the principal sum of \$20,000.00 dated July 1, 1935, bearing interest at the rate of 2¾% per annum, payable semiannually, and maturing \$5000.00 on July 1st in each of the years 1937 to 1940, inclusive (the bonds maturing in the year 1940, shall be redeemable at the option of the City on and after the 1st day of July, 1936), be and the same are hereby awarded to said Edward L. Burton & Co. and First Security Trust Company of Salt Lake City, Utah, and the Treasurer of said City shall deliver said bonds to said purchaser on receipt of the purchase proceed therefore. Par value and accrued, and a premium of \$105.00. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Water Works Superintendent, Sanitary Inspector, Chief of Fire Department, Street & Park Commissioner.

The following Resolution was read:

“RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Idaho Falls Bedding Company opened a mattress factory at 500 North Water Avenue without any permit from the City of Idaho Falls; and,

WHEREAS, same is situate in a Residence District and constitutes a continuing nuisance to the surrounding property owners and residents:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Attorney be directed and authorized to close and abate said factory as a public nuisance.”
