

JUNE 17, 1935

Minutes of a Recessed Meeting of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 7th, 1935, and recessed until June 17th, 1935.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Ewart, Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Wright; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1935-1936 AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILLS ON THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crowley, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Wright; Motion carried. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley; Absent: Wright; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley; Absent: Wright; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading and be adopted, passed and approved. An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 192 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION OF TANKS FOR THE STORAGE OF GASOLINE AND OTHER INFLAMMABLE LIQUIDS: PROVIDING THAT NO SUCH TANK SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED OR LOCATED IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE CITY COUNCIL, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wing, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Wright; Motion carried. Application for \$1,000.00 bond to Maryland Casualty Company for bond to cover application for permit on filing on 200 cubic feet per second of water on Warm River power site was read. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the application and also the bond. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Wright; Motion carried.
