

JUNE 7, 1935

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 7th, 1935.

Application for building permit No. 1162 signed by the Yale Oil Corporation was read. The Council decided to hold this application and see if it complied with the City Ordinance.

Designation of Depository applications from the American National Bank and First Security Bank of Idaho Falls requesting that each bank be designated as depository for such public moneys was read. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Wright, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Designation of Depository applications. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley and Crabtree; Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The City of Idaho Falls is the owner of the following described real property:

All that Portion of Lots 41, 42, 43, 44 and 45 in Block 8, Dwight's Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, that is east of the right of way of the Yellowstone Highway more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 45, Block 8, of Dwight's Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and running thence south along the east

line of said Lot 45, 124 feet to the south property line of said Block 8; thence west along the south property line of said Block 8, 113.0 feet to the

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easterly line of the Yellowstone Highway; thence northeasterly along the easterly line of the Yellowstone Highway 154.2 feet to the north property line of Lot 45 of said Block 8; thence east along the north property line of Lot 45 of said Block 8; thence east along the north property line of said Lot 45, 21.3 feet to the point of beginning; and

WHEREAS, said real property was not acquired, and has never been used, as a public park, playground, or public building site and is not needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention to sell said property has been published once each week for two successive weeks in the Post Register; and,

WHEREAS, Harry Hemler has made and presented a bid in the sum of \$10.00 as the purchase price of said property, and it appears that said bid made by Harry Hemler is the highest and best bid made for said property and that same should be accepted;

NOW, THEREFORE, , BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL that said bid of Harry Hemler's in the sum of \$10.00 be approved and accepted and that the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized and instructed to execute and deliver a good and sufficient Quitclaim Deed of said property to Harry Hemler."

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Gourley, that the Resolution be adopted, and the Mayor be authorized to sign the Quitclaim Deed covering the sale of these Lots for Harry Hemler. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright; Absent: Crabtree, and Crowley; Motion carried.

The following applications for water extensions were read: Ada Rowberry, W. J. Rushton, J. A. McKenzie, Wm. E. Chinn, Mrs. Clarence Smith. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light and Water Committee.

A Resolution approving gift of Lots 1 to 32, inclusive, Block 3, South Park Addition from Bonneville County to the City of Idaho Falls was read. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Crabtree and Crowley; Motion carried.

Councilman Wilkie of the Police Committee stated that the Police Committee had arrived at an agreement with the Chief of Police wherein a Pound-master could be employed by the City. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wing, that I. B. Tolley be hired as Pound-master at a salary of \$30.00 per month beginning June 1, 1935, and he is to receive \$1.00 for each license collected and \$1.00 for each dog he kills. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Wing; Absent: Crowley and Crabtree; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting recess until June 17th, 1935, at 8 o'clock P.M. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Crowley, and Crabtree; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 21st day of June, 1935.
