Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held May 3rd, 1935.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Gourley; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following Resolution was presented and read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of April, 1935, at Idaho Falls, Idaho, the regular City Election was duly held in the respective Ward of the said City for the purpose of electing a Mayor, City Clerk, City Treasurer, and two Councilmen for each of the Wards of said City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, did meet Friday evening, May 3rd, 1935, in the City Hall of said City, the same being the First Regular Meeting of said Council after said Election; and,

WHEREAS, the said official returns of said City Election for the respective Wards of said City were then in due and regular form duly presented to said City Council for the official count; and,

WHEREAS, said City Council did duly and regularly canvass the official returns of said City Election;

WHEREAS, from the official returns and the canvass made thereof by the City Council, it appears that Barzilla W. Clark received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Mayor, and that Lee Walker, received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Clerk, and that Jessie M. Hanson received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Treasurer; and that Gradie S. Evans and A. H. Wilkie received the majorities of votes cast for the offices of Councilmen for the First Ward; that Ray B. Crabtree and John T. Wing received the majorities

of the votes cast for the offices of Councilmen for the Second Ward; and that R. B. Ewart and F. Wm. Gourley received the majorities of the votes cast for the offices of Councilmen for the
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Third Ward; and that Stanley Crowley and Worth D. Wright received the majorities of the votes cast for the offices of Councilmen for the Fourth Ward of said City;

The application of E. R. Pierce was presented to the Council. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light & Water Committee.

An Ordinance entitled," AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, TO GRADE, GRAVEL, PRIME COAT, TACK COAT, PAVE AND SURFACE DRAIN CERTAIN STREETS AND PARTS OF STREETS WITHIN SAID CITY: TO CREATE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. _____ FOR IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING SAID IMPROVEMENTS: TO DEFRAY THE COST AND ASSESSMENTS LEVIED UPON AND AGAINST THE LOTS AND LANDS ABUTTING, ADJOINING, AND ADJACENT TO THE STREET OR STREETS TO BE SO IMPROVED, AND ON AND AGAINST ALL LOTS AND LANDS BENEFITED BY SUCH IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDED IN SAID DISTRICT. AND TO PAY THE REMAINDER OF THE COST AND EXPENSES OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING THE WHOLE COST AND EXPENSES OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS TO BE AN ORIGINAL IMPROVEMENT OR IMPROVEMENTS: FIXING THE TIME WHEN PROTESTS AGAINST SAID IMPROVEMENTS AND THE CREATION OF SAID DISTRICT MAY BE FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK, AND WHEN SUCH PROTESTS WILL BE HEARD AND CONSIDERED BY THE

CITY COUNCIL: GIVING THE KIND AND CHARACTER OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ESTIMATED TOTAL COST THEREOF AND ORDERING THE PUBLICATION HEREOF," was presented to the Council by Councilman Wright. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be

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read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried. The Clerk read the Ordinance again and it was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk, It was moved by Evans, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance pass on its third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Chairman Ewart of the Electric Light & Water Committee stated that some action must be taken in regard to the way money is being spent on Well No. 3. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wilkie, that the City Engineer make an accounting as to the cost per foot of the drilling of Well No. 3 and all money which has been spent on this well to date for labor and material. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that portions of Lots 26-27-28-29-30 in Block 9 of Dwight's Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, be advertised for sale. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wing, that the Meeting recess until next Friday, April 10th, 1935, at 8 P.M. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Crowley; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.
