Current Transformer and 2200 Volt Potential Transformer; 2 only Type PQ 5 Amp. Circuit Opening Overload Relays Inverse Time Element. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to place an order for the above material. The following petition was read:

**“ TO THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO**

We, the undersigned citizens of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and vicinity, do respectfully request and urge that you take action at once in the matter of opening a street from the North of Idaho Avenue to the intersection of Anderson Street and the Lewisville Road, same to be made suitable for heavy traffic.”

The Mayor referred same to the Street and Ditch Committee.

An Ordinance entitled, “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 505 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, AND MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY MINOR UNDER THE AGE OF FOURTEEN YEARS TO BE ON THE STREETS, ALLEYS, OR IN ANY UNOCCUPIED PLACE AFTER TEN O’CLOCK P.M.” was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Evans, that the Ordinance pass on its First reading. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Absent: Wright and Crowley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wilkie, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Absent: Wright and Crowley; Motion carried. Passed and approved this 19<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1935.
