Election to be held in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on Tuesday, April 23, 1935, was the first order of business to come before the Meeting.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Gourley, that the City Clerk be ordered to publish said notice of the coming City Election to be held April 23, 1935. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

Councilmen from the First Ward recommended the following appointments for First Ward: Deputy Registrar: Mattie Schaumleffel; Judges of Election: George Davis, Mrs. Joe Nelson, J. M. Spriggs, Allie K. Hanson, H. Mark Earl, James Westergard; Constable: Sid Whitehead. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Evans, that the above appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

Councilmen for the Second Ward recommended the following appointments for the Second Ward: Deputy Registrar: Minnie Neal; Judges of Election: M. F. Marker, Mary Holden, Alice Boomer; Constable: A. H. Blair. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the above appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

Councilmen from the Third Ward recommended the following appointments for the Third Ward: Deputy Registrar, Mrs. Sabra Allen; Judges of Election: Emma Shoenhuth, Fred A. Blake, Mrs. E. A. Miller, Mrs. Wm. Powell, Mrs. Ed Sullivan, Mrs. John Coder; Constable: M. F. King. It was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Ewart, that the above appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Motion carried.

Councilmen from the Fourth Ward recommended the following appointments for the Fourth Ward: Deputy Registrar: Emma Carter; Judges of Election: V. A. Stewart, Mrs. J. C. Rushton, Mrs. E. L. Barnett, Mrs. Roy Pickett, Mrs. Chas. Mack, Mrs. Fred A. Swanson; Constable: Chas. Mooney. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the above appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Deputy Registrars for the coming City Election be paid ten cents per name for each name now registered, and all additional names which they register in their Ward. The Deputy Registrars must make a house to house canvass of their Wards and check the names of Electors now listed and register all Electors who are not on the present register books. The Deputy Registrars shall prepare the necessary check lists for each Ward after all Electors are registered in each Ward. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Motion carried.

Claim for weekly mileage of Rachel Ohme, I. E. R. A. nurse for Bonneville County for weeks of March 1<sup>st</sup>, to 14<sup>th</sup>, 1935, at Six Dollars (\$6.00) per week was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wilkie, that the claim for \$12.00 be paid and the City pay a maximum of \$6.00 each week to Rachel Ohme. I.E.R.A. nurse for mileage. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried.

Chairman Wright of the Street and Ditch Committee presented petitions soliciting the Mayor and Council to start proceedings for the creation of local improvement paving districts. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Evans, that the City Attorney be authorized to draw up a Resolution of intention to create improvement districts covering petitions now filed with the Street Commissioner. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.
