

NOVEMBER 16, 1934

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held November 16th, 1934.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Mehlhoff; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of previous Meetings were read and approved.

The following bids for Police Radio Transmitter and equipment were opened and read:

The Mayor referred the above bids to the Police Committee and the Finance Committee with power to act on same.

The following application for license was read: Broadway Rooms, by D. B. Nielsen for Rooming House at 475 Broadway. The above application was approved by Chairman Gourley of the Police Committee and the Chief of Police. Councilman Crowley of the Police Committee refused to sign the application. Councilman Mehlhoff, the other member of the Police Committee was absent. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Wilkie, that the license be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Wilkie; Nay: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Ewart; Motion lost.

The following applications for licenses were read: E. J. Clemons - Fruit Peddler and Kenneth D. Reeder - Taxi Cab. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Gourley, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley; Motion carried.

The following building permits were read:

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the building permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Motion carried.

The following applications for water extensions were read: Mary Baker and Harry L. Weeks. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light & Water Committee.

The resignation of Alvina M. Wilson as City Treasurer was read. It was moved by Evans, seconded by seconded by Wright, that the resignation be accepted. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

A letter from E. T. Vance written to Jack Holmes regarding the leasing of a hangar at the Airport was read. The Mayor referred same to the Special Airport Committee.

Councilman Ewart stated that D. E. Rathbun has not moved the house off the lots which the City purchased from him to be used for the right of way, and some action should be taken to compel him to move these houses. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that D. E. Rathbun be instructed to move the houses off the lots which were purchased from him to be used for the right of way, and if he does not move the houses the City will move them at his expense, deducting said expense from the balance due Mr. Rathbun on the purchase price of these lots. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree; Nay: Wilkie; Absent: Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

A power and load study report covering the present and probable load to assist in planning the development to be cared for in our electrical system was presented and explained by M. P. Goudy, City Electrician.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree.

It was passed and approved this 7th day of December, 1934.
