After considering all applications for City Treasurer, the Mayor appointed Mrs. W. P. Hanson to fill the unexpired term of Mrs. Alvina M. Wilson as City Treasurer. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crowley, that the appointment be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

A report of the Special Airport Committee was read by Councilman Wright. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the report of the Special Airport Committee be approved and the same be referred to the City Attorney for completion of all contracts and agreements. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wright, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.
