

NOVEMBER 2, 1934

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held November 2nd, 1934.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of previous Meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, Police Judge, City Electrician, Water Master, Chief of Police, Sanitary Inspector, Street and Park Commissioner, Chief of Fire Department.

An agreement between Ralph A. Louis and City of Idaho Falls covering the purchase of Lot 9, in Block 3 of Original Townsite was read.
