The following applications for licenses were read: Polama Room, Rooming House; Polama Rooms, Retail Beer. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Evans, that the application for Rooming House license be granted and application for license to Retail Beer be rejected. Also in the future no

licenses will be granted to any Rooming House to sell beer. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

Supplement No. 1 to Easement A. C. E. No. 6643 Audit No. 6819 O. S. L. Railroad Company to City of Idaho Falls, was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the Mayor be authorized to sign said Easement. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 417, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NOS. 421, 424 AND 443 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FIXING A FLAT RATE FOR ELECTRIC TANK HEATER SERVICE AND LIMITING THE CAPACITY OF ANY ONE INSTALLMENT, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Evans, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second, third, and final readings. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Evans, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading and be adopted, passed and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 474 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Councilman Ewart, Chairman of the Electric Light and Water Committee, requested that the Purchasing be authorized to order one carload of pipe, which we must have before anymore water extensions can be made. The cost would be \$2228.25 and payment for same can be made January 1st, 1935. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wilkie, that an order be placed for a carload of pipe with the C. W. & M. Co. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried.

A letter from Alvin Denman requesting the City to correct an unsanitary condition on Pine Street and West 13th Street where several horses have been corralled was read. The Mayor referred same to the Sanitary Inspector.

A letter from Northeastern Idaho Planning Board by H. B. Sheppard, Chairman, requesting the Mayor to appoint a City Planning Board was read. The Mayor appointed the following to act on the Board, C. R. Black, Geo. M. Scott and M. P. Goudy.

Chairman Crowley of the Finance Committee requested that a transfer of \$2427.01 be made from the General Fund to Special Improvement Districts as per quarterly audit report May 1, 1934, to July 31, 1934. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that transfer be made according to

suggestion of Auditor, Fred E. Ring. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Evans; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 19th day of October, 1934.
