It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

The following building permits were read: No. 1056 signed by Dwight Henry; No. 1057 signed by Leonard G. Ball. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

A letter from Ralph A. Louis requesting the City to purchase his Lot No. 9, Block 3, Original Townsite for \$550.00 was read. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light and Water Committee.

A petition from property owners on East Tenth Street requesting the City to gravel three blocks east on Tenth Street from Holmes Avenue to Cranmer Street was read. No action was taken by the Council.

A petition for reconsideration of claim of J. T. Evans was read. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light & Water Committee.

An Ordinance entitled: AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND SERVING OF BEER AND OTHER BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Absent: Evans; Motion carried. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and that the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Absent: Evans; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Crowley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Absent: Evans; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading and be adopted, passed and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Absent: Evans; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 473 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The Electric Light and Water Committee recommended that the following applications for water extensions be approved: Dean Albright, etal and Leonard Flitton, etal. It was moved by **SEPTEMBER 7, 1934**

Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the recommendation of the Electric Light and Water Committee be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.
