

AUGUST 17, 1934

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 17th, 1934.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of previous Meetings were read and approved.

The following building permits were read: No. 1053 signed by William Clark; No. 1054 signed by George M. Jensen; No. 1055, signed by R. L. King. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the permits be approved. Building Permit No. 1051 signed by the Texas Company was read. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the permit be approved providing that the Texas Company will not construct any part of service station on City property, and no gas tanks are to be buried under sidewalk or gas pumps installed by curb. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Building permit No. 1049 covering the construction of a potato cellar on Lomax Street was presented by the Building Committee and they recommended that the permit be granted and approved. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the permit be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Nay: None; Motion carried.

A letter from Dr. G. B. Crabtree of the American Legion requesting permission to use the first two blocks on Memorial Drive for a carnival on September 12th, 13th, and 14th was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that permission be granted as requested. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Gourley, Crabtree, Nay: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion lost.

Councilman Wright stated that on account of the trees and new grass on Memorial Drive another location should be found to hold the street carnival next month. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crowley, that the matter be referred to the Park Committee with power to act. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Street & Ditch Committee recommended that an appropriation of \$25.00 be made to cover examination expense of Plumbers for the Plumbers Examining Board. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the recommendation of the Street & Ditch Committee be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Motion carried.
