Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1934.

There were present at said Meeting: Mayor Barzilla W. Clark; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Absent: None; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of previous Meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, Police Judge, City Electrician, Chief of Police, Sanitary Inspector, Water Master, Street and Park Commissioner, Chief of Fire Department.

The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light and Water Committee.

A petition requesting the City Council to demand that H. M. Groesbeck move the Holland Furnace Warehouse located on the alley between 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Streets, signed by the following property owners, was read: Ed Barnett, A. B. Anderson, Mrs. Anna Melquist, E. Dixon, James A Gamble . The Mayor referred same to the City Attorney.

A letter from D. G. Sautter, Chairman of the Board of Examining Plumbers, requesting the City to donate \$50.00 to cover examination expenses for Plumbers was read. The Mayor referred same to the Street and Ditch Committee.

The Electric Light Committee recommended that the City pay Mike Marshall \$100.00 for his electric light line from the railroad crossing south covering his portion of the line inside the City limits. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Gourley, that the recommendation of the Electric Light Committee be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Nay: None; Motion carried.

A request for free water from G. W. Churchill of 431 E. 17<sup>th</sup> Street was read. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light and Water Committee.

R. B. Ewart, Chairman of the Electric Light and Water Committee, stated that the present system of regulating the watering days was unsatisfactory as there was no way of keeping the pressure evenly distributed in the water mains. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wright, that starting Monday, August 6<sup>th</sup>, 1934, all odd numbers of residences in the City water on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays and all even numbers of residences water on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Chairman Wright of the Street and Ditch Committee stated that the Seed Company located south of Market Street wants water and sewer service. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wright, that the City Engineer prepare an estimate of the cost for water and sewer extension for property owners on this Street. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting recess until next Friday Night at 8 P.M., August 10, 1934. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 17<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1934.
