Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held July 20th, 1934.

There were present at said Meeting: Mayor Barzilla W. Clark; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Absent: Evans; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of previous Meetings were read and approved.

The following applications for licenses were read:

A Bill of Sale covering the Emma P. Mulhall house sold to Mike Marshall for \$450.00 was read. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the Mayor be authorized to sign said bill of sale. An application for water extension signed by the following property owners in Block 61, Highland Park Addition was read: Dean Albright, Leonard Foster, Arthur Lake, Mrs. Herman Hammon and Mrs. Lottie Peterson. The Mayor referred the application to the Electric Light and Water Committee.

The following building permits were read: No. 1041 signed by Max Clark, No. 1042 signed by Eli Webb, No. 1043 signed by M. R. Ferguson. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the building permits be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

The following radio bids were opened and read: Perlewitz Graybar Electric Co., 7480.95; Heintz & Kaufman Ltd., 5911.50; R. C. A. Victor Company, Inc., 8900.00. The Mayor referred the bids to the Police Committee and the Finance Committee.
