Building Permit No. 1039 signed by G. E. Pope was read. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crowley, that the Building Permit be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.

A release and cancellation of bond dated January 31st, 1933, for \$2,000.00 on C. A. Carlson, issued by United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company was read. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the release. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.

Councilman Wilkie stated that the City should request the State Highway Department to connect "F" Street on to the new highway as it will be a detriment to residents on "F" Street and residents of North Section if this street is closed. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that

the Highway Department permit the City of Idaho Falls to connect "F" Street with the new highway, and that the City Engineer prepare plans before July 16th, 1934, to present to the State Highway

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Gourley; Motion carried.
