

JUNE 5, 1934

Minutes of a recessed Meeting of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho held June 1st, 1934, and recessed until June 5th, 1934.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Wright; Absent: Mehlhoff, and Crowley; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Councilman Wilkie stated that the salary of the Street Commissioner should be raised in the Budget for the Fiscal Year 1934-1935, \$120.00, as three other appointive employees salaries had been raised. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the salary of the Street Commissioner be raised Ten Dollars per month. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans; Absent: Mehlhoff and Crowley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Crabtree, that we transfer \$5000.00 from the Electric Light Department item No. 65 to the General Fund, same to be appropriated as follows: City Parks-\$2500.00 and General Contingencies-\$2500.00. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Nay: Ewart; Absent: Mehlhoff and Crowley; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1934-1935 AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILLS ON THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Evans, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Crowley and Mehlhoff; Motion carried. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and that the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart; Absent: Crowley and Mehlhoff; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Gourley, seconded by Evans, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading and be adopted, passed and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 472 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The Swedish Mission Church wants the City to make Water connection for sprinkling system on church lawn and donate the cost of material and labor estimated by the Water Department to be about \$19.40. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light & Water Committee. Councilman Wright stated that action must be taken to safeguard tools, material and equipment stored in the City Garage as attendants at the garage are delivering City property to any person who calls for same without knowing who the person is or where the property is being taken to. It was moved by

Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the Purchasing Agent be instructed to put up a sign in the City Garage reading that no material, tools, or equipment is to be delivered to any person, or removed

from the garage building or premises without a written order from the Purchasing Agent. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Wright; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Gourley, that the Meeting recess until next Friday night, June 8th, 1934. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 15th day of June, 1934.
