

JUNE 1, 1934

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 1st, 1934.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk, Councilmen Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Crowley; when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

Minutes of previous Meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, Police Judge, City Electrician, Chief of Police, Sanitary Inspector, Street Commissioner, Chief of Fire Department, Water Master.

The Idaho Falls Plumbers Association selected the following Plumbers to act as members of the Plumber's Examining Board and requests the Mayor to appoint them for one year: Master Plumbers: D. G. Sautter, Sr., W. S. Smith; Journeyman Plumbers: Freeman Hansen, N. O. Brown. The Mayor then appointed the above Plumbers to act on said Board. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Evans, that the appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Nay: Mehlhoff; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

A Bill of Sale covering one 1933 Chevrolet Sedan, Motor #3601751, Serial #5CA05 21095, which was traded in on 1934 Ford V-8 Sedan to Bonneville Auto Company for \$500.00 was read. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Gourley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign said Bill of Sale. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

An Agreement between the Idaho Emergency Relief Administration and the City of Idaho Falls covering Workmen's Compensation Insurance on all FERA workers on projects in the City of Idaho Falls, and employees application for insurance policy showing advance deposit of \$100.00 and annual policy charge of \$3.00 was read. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wilkie, that the Mayor be authorized to sign Agreement and insurance application, and that the \$103.00 be mailed to State Insurance Fund. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Wright; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

A Petition was read signed by all residents at the corner of 13th Street and Boulevard, who request that the City condemn frame house located at 1270 S. Boulevard. The Mayor referred same to the Sanitary Department and Building and Fire Committees.

H. M. Groesbeck obtained a building permit on January 5, 1934, to construct a garage at 120 5th Street, and said building is now being used to store Holland furnaces. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Crabtree, that the building be confined to a garage and not to be used as a warehouse. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

Chairman Gourley of the Police Committee requested that the Chief of Police, C. A. Carlson, be authorized to attend the Northwest Peace Officers Convention at Vancouver, B. C. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that Chief of Police, C. A. Carlson, be authorized to use \$100.00 from the Police Department Miscellaneous Fund in 1934-1935 Budget as expenses to convention at Vancouver, B.C. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

The Mayor stated that the Utah-Idaho Sugar Company will pay the City \$2500.00 and their old sewer for a permit to connect their sewer on to the storm sewer. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting recess until next Tuesday, June 5th, 1934. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.
