An Agreement, dated April 10, 1934, between Merland Clark and LeRoy Clark, and the City of Idaho Falls covering the manufacturing of approximately 15,000 feet of concrete sewer pipe was read. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Mayor be authorized to sign said Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE OREGON SHORT LINE RAILROAD COMPANY, AND TO ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, A FRANCHISE AND RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, AND MAINTAIN A STANDARD GAUGE SPUR RAILROAD TRACK OVER AND ACROSS EASTERN AVENUE ADJACENT TO BLOCKS TWENTY-SEVEN (27) AND TWENTY-EIGHT (28) OF THE ORIGINAL TOWNSITE OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO," was read by the Clerk, for the second time. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Gourley, that the Ordinance pass its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was read again by the Clerk. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading.
