An Agreement and Deed covering the transfer of the of the Idaho Falls Country Club property to the City of Idaho Falls was read. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wright, that the Mayor be authorized to sign said Agreement and Deed. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

A Sales Contract between the City Oil Company and the City of Idaho Falls covering the purchase of a 15,800 gallon storage tank for the sum of \$825.00 was read. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to sign said Contract. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

A new Plumbing Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 770, 772, 773, AND AMENDING SECTION 790 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON OTHER THAN A LICENSED MASTER PLUMBER OR HIS EMPLOYEES TO DO PLUMBING WORK WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: DEFINING THE TERM 'MASTER PLUMBER' AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXAMINATION OF AN APPLICANT BEFORE ISSUING TO HIM A MASTER PLUMBER'S LICENSE: CREATING A MASTER PLUMBER'S EXAMINING BOARD AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE BY SAID BOARD; PROVIDING FOR THE SIZE AND MATERIAL

OF WASTE PIPES AND THE METHOD OF INSTALLATION THEREOF: AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" was read. It was moved

by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance pass its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wright, that the Mayor be authorized to sign contract with the General Electric Company covering the purchase of material to regulate the tank heaters by controllers, etc., in the amount of \$8860.00. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

Audit report for the last quarter was read and commented on by Councilman Wright of the Finance Committee.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Wright; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.
