It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the recommendation of the Finance Committee be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Motion carried.

An Agreement between the City of Idaho Falls and Merland Clark and Leroy Clark, covering the manufacturing of 9000 feet of concrete sewer pipe was read. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crowley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign said Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A LICENSE TAX ON RETAILERS OF BEER WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: PROVIDING FOR THE AMOUNT OF SAID TAX AND THE ANNUAL DATE OF THE EXPIRATION OF SAID LICENSE: PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF REVENUE THERE FROM AND FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A LICENSE AND THE RECORD THEREOF AND DISPLAY OF SAME: DEFINING THE TERM 'RETAILER' AND PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF HIS BUSINESS AND THE HOURS WHEN BEER SHALL NOT BE SOLD: PROHIBITING DANCING IN A RETAILER'S PLACE OF BUSINESS: AND PROVIDING SANITARY RULES CONCERNING SAME: PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION OF THE LICENSES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS: AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wright, that the Ordinance pass its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Nay: Wilkie; Motion carried.

Fire Chief Marker stated to the Council that his Department was in need of 700 feet of new fire hose, and same should be purchased as soon as possible. He also stated that this amount of hose was provided for in the budget this year. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase 500 feet of new fire hose for the Fire Department. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Motion carried.

Councilman Ewart stated that the City Electrical, M. P. Goudy, and he had made a trip to Pocatello to inspect the oil storage tank owned by the City Oil Company and had made an Agreement to purchase their 15,000 gallon tank for \$1000.00, F. O. B. Pocatello, as is. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Evans, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase the 15,000 gallon tank from the City Oil Company of Pocatello, price to be \$1,000.00 F. O. B. Pocatello. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Nay: Wilkie; Motion carried.

A. Ross Rutherford addressed the Council and stated that he would need about ten sacks of cement to complete the Rifle Range and the National Guard did not have any funds for any item of this nature. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the City donate ten sacks of cement

to Company A.116 Engineers to be used in constructing their Rifle Range. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Nay: Wilkie; Motion carried.

City Engineer C. R. Black stated that the Government office at Boise offers to have a resurvey made which will fix meander and boundary lines, and suggests that the offer on the part of the Government be accepted by the City. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Gourley, that we accept the offer made by the Government Engineer to make a resurvey of the meander and boundary lines of the Snake River which runs through the City. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

A Resolution presented by J. T. McEntee was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wilkie, that the Resolution be referred to the Street and Ditch Committee for recommendation. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, Police Judge, City Electrician, Water Master, Chief of Police, Sanitary Inspector, Chief of Fire Department, Street and Park Commissioner.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Motion carried.
