It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Crabtree, that the recommendation of the Finance Committee be approved and the Mayor be authorized to sign the Resolution prepared by the First Security Bank of Idaho, Idaho Falls, Branch, which designates its as a depository. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley; Motion carried.

Agreement covering relief funds, between the Federal Government, State of Idaho, Bonneville County and the City of Idaho Falls was presented by Councilman Crowley. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement with the State of Idaho covering the relief money put up by the State, County and City whereby the City puts up \$2500.00, the County \$1500.00, the State \$4000.00 and the Federal Government \$4000.00. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Motion carried.

City Engineer C. R. Black, stated that he would have to have a pump to pump off the water seepage that is coming into the new well, and a good pump could be purchased for about \$490.00 and the necessary pipe to operate same would cost about \$175.00. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.
