Councilman Ewart stated that a committee should be appointed by the Mayor to wait on C. J. Taylor, District Judge, asking that he appoint a board of appraisers to appraise property on the right of way of new highway. Councilmen Ewart, Crowley, and Wilkie were appointed by the Mayor to wait on Judge Taylor, asking that a board of appraisers be appointed by the Court for the purpose of appraisal of property, and fixing of a fair price on property needed for the right of way.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried.
