It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the claim be allowed. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, and Gourley; Nay: Evans, Crabtree, Crowley, Wright; Motion lost.

An application from Postal Telegraph Cable Company for permit to contact on five City poles starting at a point first pole east from Weyl-Zuckerman warehouse, east five poles on West Broadway was read. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that the permit be granted and proper contract be prepared to cover same. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.
