

NOVEMBER 3, 1933

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held November 3rd, 1933.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

The following monthly reports were read, approved and ordered filed: City Clerk, Police Judge, City Electrician, Chief of Police, Street & Park Commissioner, Sanitary Inspector, Water Master, Chief of Fire Department.

The following applications for licenses were read:

Bernice Jackson	Rooming House-Rex Hotel
C. A. McEschern	Soft Drinks
Lewis Funk	Soft Drinks

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Evans, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley; Motion carried.

The following building permits were read:

Chas. J. Coughlin, construct second floor over Old Faithful Bottling Works
A. N. Johnson, addition to dwelling on Fifth Street

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the building permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried.

A letter from the Hockey and Skating Committee of the Lions Club regarding a municipal skating rink at South Park Addition was read. The Mayor referred same to the Park Committee.

The following Resolution was introduced by Ewart, who moved its adoption which motion was seconded by Crowley:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, has during the past several years carried on an extensive program of public improvements through the expenditure of monies made available from the revenues of the Electric Light Department, the Water Department and through the regular tax levy; and,

WHEREAS, it has been necessary to carry on this program of public improvements as a relief measure to provide work for the unemployed; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the condition of the unemployed will require the continuation of the public improvement program in the future; and,

WHEREAS, there is included in the current budget certain sums to carry on said work; and,

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has made available through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works financial assistance for carrying out the unemployment program;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That application be made through proper channels by the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for the 30% grant on the following projects, to wit:

1. Storm Sewer Extension to the Utah-Idaho Co., sewer at the intersection of "G" Street and Eastern Avenue.
2. Completion of City Well #3.
3. The installation of an elevated water tank of 500,000 gallon capacity.
4. The installation of the second hydro-electric unit at Power Plant #2 of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the Police be instructed to keep trucks from parking on Park Avenue between Broadway and C Street, and Broadway to C Street on Shoup Avenue and A & B Streets. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree; Nay: Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crowley, that the City Engineer write to the Department of Public Works for a set of plans covering the proposed new highway and G Street subway. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting recess until next Tuesday evening, November 7th, 1933, at 8 o'clock P.M. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 7th day of November, 1933.
