

AUGUST 18, 1933

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 18th, 1933 were recorded.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Absent: Gourley, when the following proceedings were had to wit:

AN ORDINANCE "PROVIDING FOR A LICENSE TAX ON DOGS KEPT, OR HARBORED WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE SAID TAX AND THE ANNUAL DATE OF THE EXPIRATION OF SAID LICENSE: PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A LICENSE AND RECORD THEREOF AND THE TAG AS EVIDENCE OF PAYMENT, PROVIDING AND DECLARING THAT ALL DOGS NOT LICENSED ARE PUBLIC NUISANCES AND AUTHORIZING THE SEIZURE AND DESTRUCTION OF UNLICENSED DOGS: PROVIDING THAT THE POSSESSION OR HARBORING OF A DOG UPON WHICH A LICENSE IS NOT PAID SHALL BE A CRIMINAL OFFENSE AND THE PUNISHMENT THEREFORE: AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance pass its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart; Motion carried. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance pass its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read by the Clerk and it was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading, and be adopted, passed and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 466 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application of R. M. Talbot for free water for one year on Lots 16 to 24, Block 10, Capital Hill Addition was read. No action was taken.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Motion carried.

Letter and proposal from Wallace & Tiernan Co., Inc., regarding repairing of type M. S. A. chlorinator at an estimated cost of \$100.00 and the purchase of a new vacuum type chlorinator at a price of \$1180.00 was read. The Mayor referred same to the Electric Light & Water Committee.

A Resolution from the licensed Dairy Operators of Idaho Falls was read. The Mayor ordered same filed.

LeRoy W. Beam, Superintendent of the City schools, and two members of the Parent Teachers Association appeared before the Council and requested that the City appropriate \$1200.00 for a school nurse for the City schools for a period of nine months. The Mayor referred the request to the Finance Committee.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Mehlhoff, Ewart, Crowley; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 8th day of September, 1933.
