

MAY 7, 1930

The Council met in recess session on the above date at the hour of eight o'clock.

There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, Harry H. Payne, City Clerk, and Councilmen Brandl, Ewart, Holmes, Rigby, Anderson, Rhule and Coy, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

This being the time set for the opening and considering of bids for the construction of the new City Hall unit and there having been filed with the City Clerk three bids for the general construction, four bids for the tile work, three bids for the brick work, the Clerk did on orders of the Mayor and Council, open and read the same as follows:

It was moved by Brandl, seconded by Holmes, that the City of Idaho Falls contribute \$100.00 to the G. A. R. for expenses for a reunion to be held in Idaho Falls during the month of June 1930. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Brandl, that the meeting recess until May 8, 1930 at 8 P.M. Roll call voting aye; Brandl, Ewart and Rhule, voting nay; Coy, Rigby and Anderson, passing Holmes, absent and not voting; Randall, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion lost.

At this time Councilmen Rhule, Ewart and Brandl left the meeting.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Anderson, that we do now recess until May 8, 1930, at 8 P.M. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
