Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

A claim of Emily E. and Geo. W. Polson, in the sum of \$15,000.00 for injuries sustained by Mrs. Polson when she fell on the streets of Idaho Falls was read and referred to the City Attorney.

An application of Harry Bennet for water extension to 24th Street and Hibgy Avenue, was presented and referred to the Light and Water Committee.

The report of F. L. McGrew covering his inspection of the plans for the new City Hall was ordered file.

It was moved by Brandl, seconded by Coy, that the meeting recess until 8 P.M., May 7, 1930. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
