It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Coy, that the claims be allowed and warrants issued on proper funds in payment of same. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Ewart, that the claims of Geo. Tway in the amount of \$34.75 and Berne Walton in the amount of \$27.60 be rejected. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Brandl, seconded by Rhule, that the claim of Anderson & Sons Lumber Company in the sum of \$6.50 be allowed. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Anderson, seconded by Brandl, that the claim of Wm. Williams in the sum of \$44.00 for series rendered as Desk Sergeant be allowed. Roll call voting aye; Holmes, Rigby, Anderson, Rhule, Brandl and Ewart, voting nay; Coy, absent and not voting; Randall, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

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It was moved by Anderson, seconded by Holmes, that J. E. Compton be confirmed as Patrolman on the Police Force. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Coy, that the application of Jocquin Negrete for a license for a lunch counter be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

As these permits had been checked and OK'd by F. L. McGrew Building Inspector, it was moved by Brandl, seconded by Rhule, that the applications be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Brandl, that the City Clerk be authorized to make the transfers on books of the City covering the several accounts attached hereto. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by coy, that the claims issued against the Electric Extension Fund in the sum of \$281.00 and \$1,052.45 be paid out of the General Fund. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Rhule, that the report of Airport Committee and T. R. Peters, attached hereto be accepted and made a part of the City records. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

A communication from Otto McCutcheon regarding the levying of a one mill tax for the payment of delinquent improvement bonds was read and referred to the Finance Committee.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Brandl, that the communication of Stephenson Bros., regarding any further payments to be made to the Byron Jackson Pump Company, be referred to the City Attorney. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

A communication from the West Coast Steel Company was read and referred to the Street and Ditch Committee.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Ewart, that the recommendation of the Building Committee, that the City accept the proposal of Northwestern Terra Cotta Company to furnish the terra cotta for the Fire Station and City Hall buildings at the sum of \$10,990.00, be accepted. Roll call voting aye; Coy, Brandl, Ewart, Anderson and Rhule, voting nay; Rigby, passing and not voting; Holmes, absent and not voting; Randall, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

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It was moved by Coy, seconded by Brandl, that the council recommend that the Legion pay Mr. Tolley \$12.50 for the past five month's janitor service. Roll call voting aye; Coy, Brandl and Rigby, voting nay; Anderson, Rhule, Ewart and Holmes, absent and not voting; Randall, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion lost.

A communication from the Idaho Cold Storage Company was read and same was referred to the Electric Light and Water Committee.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Coy, that the application of J. W. Hackbarth for ground space at the City Airport be referred to the Airport Committee. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The application of B. F. Wing was referred to the Airport Committee.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Brandl, that the Airport Committee is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into and make leases of portions of the City Airport. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rigby, seconded by Holmes, that the claim of Charles E. Freeze in the sum of \$500.00, purchase price of Lots 11, 12, Block 74, Edgewater Addition be allowed. Roll call voting aye; Rigby, Anderson, Coy, Ewart and Holmes, voting nay; Rhule and Brandl, absent and not voting; Randall.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Anderson, that the purchase of 23½' on west side of City Hall on C Street be referred to Finance Committee. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Brandl, that we place order for metallic doors and frames with the Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company of Los Angeles, at their alternate quotation for furnishing plain dark color enamel for the basement units, instead of grained mahogany finish as specified for the remainder of the building, at a price of \$4,508.00 f.o.b., Idaho Falls. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Brandl, seconded by Rhule, that the meeting recess until 5 P.M., Saturday, April 5, 1930. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
