

MARCH 21, 1930

The Council met in regular session on the above date at the hour of eight o'clock P.M.

There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, Harry H. Payne, City Clerk, and Councilmen Rigby, Rhule, Coy, Ewart and Holmes, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The claim of Stephenson Bros. in the sum of \$1,932.30 was presented, and it was moved by Coy, seconded by Rigby, that the claim be allowed. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Holmes, that the claim of the American LaFrance and Foamite Industries Inc., in the sum of \$4,000.00, to apply as first payment on the new fire truck be allowed. Roll call voting aye; Coy, Brandl, Holmes, Rigby and Rhule, passing and not voting; Ewart, absent and not voting; Randall and Anderson, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried. At this time Councilman Brandl entered and thereafter participated in the proceedings of the Council.

A claim of Chas. E. Freeze in the amount of \$500.00 for the purchase of Lots 11 and 12 in Block 74 was presented and it was moved by Holmes, seconded by Rigby, that the claim be allowed. Roll call voting aye; Ewart, Holmes, Rigby and Coy, voting nay; Rhule and Brandl, absent and not voting; Randall and Anderson, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion lost.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Rhule, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase all necessary hardware for the new City Hall Building. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

A claim of S. H. Kress and Company in the sum of \$921.10, covering expenses arising in connection with the property that they purchased from the City was read and it was referred to the City Engineer.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Ewart, that the council accept the plans as prescribed by Chamber of Commerce and the Beautification Committee covering the beautifying of lots on Boulevard. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rigby, seconded by Rhule, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
