

DECEMBER 20, 1929

The City Council met on the above date at the hour of 8:00 P.M. in regular session.

There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, Harry H. Payne, City Clerk, and Councilmen Rigby, Anderson, Rhule, Brandl, Holmes, absent; Coy, Ewart and Randall, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Applications filed by Jas. Bradford and Ellen Conley to operate rooming houses were read by the Clerk, and it was moved by Rhule seconded by Anderson that the applications be granted and licenses issued to them. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The water analysis was read by the Clerk and the Council ordered it placed on file.

A bill was presented and read from S. W. Kress and Company in the sum of \$921.10. This bill was referred to the City Attorney by the Mayor.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Anderson, that we do now adjourn. Voting aye; Holmes, Rigby, Anderson and Rhule, voting nay; Brandl, absent and not voting; Ewart, Randall and Coy, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
