The City Council met on the above date at the hour of 8:00 P.M. in recess session of the recess meeting held November 4, 1929.

There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, Harry H. Payne, City Clerk, and Councilmen Coy, Brandl, Ewart, Holmes, Randall, Rigby, Anderson and Rhule, absent; none, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Rhule, that the recommendation of the Finance Committee to give \$250.00 to the Salvation Army be adopted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Brandl, that the recommendation of the Electric Light and Water Committee to buy a machine to locate radio trouble be adopted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Anderson, seconded by Ewart, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the revised contract of W. L. Peeler for the Grading and Leveling of Airport. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The following application for building permit was presented:

L. L. Lambrit      Lot 1,2,3,4      Block 5      Old Town Addn.      Residence

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Brandl, that the above permit be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Randall, that the Clerk be instructed to pay the O. S. L. Railroad Company \$5.00 lease on pipe line on parking on island. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Rhule, that the contract of C. S. Crabtree for building of forms, laying of steel and pouring of concrete be accepted, and the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the contract. Roll call voting aye; Anderson, Rhule, Coy, Ewart and Holmes, voting nay; Brandl, Randall and Rigby, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Rhule, that we do now adjourn.
