

SEPTEMBER 18, 1929

We, the Electric Light & Water Committee, the Finance Committee, City Electrician and City Engineer, having duly considered all bids submitted for the pumping unit complete hereby recommend that all bids be eliminated and certified checks be returned to the bidders, with the exception of those of the Byron-Jackson Company and the Consolidated Wagon & Machine Company.

This action is recommended for the reason that more time is needed to consider these two proposals in detail.
