At this time an ordinance entitled "PROVIDING FOR A SUPERINTENDENT OF PARKS AND OTHER LANDS BELONGING TO THE CITY, PRESCRIBING HIS DUTIES, AND FIXING THE SALARY OF SUCH OFFICER" came up for passage on its third and final reading, and after the same had been read in full by the Clerk, it was moved by Ewart, seconded by Brandl, that the ordinance pass its third and final reading and be passed, adopted and approved. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The above having been approved by the Police Committee, it was moved by Ewart, seconded by Rhule, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Randall, that the Purchasing Agent be instructed to purchase a stoker for the Fire Station Building, as recommended by the Building Committee. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Rigby, that the Purchasing Agent be instructed to purchase one tank car of asphalt oil for sprinkling streets. Roll call voting aye; Coy, Ewart, Holmes, Rigby and Anderson, voting nay; Rhule, Brandl and Randall, absent and not voting; none, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Randall, that the City offices be moved from its present location to the new Fire Station Building as soon as possible. Roll call voting aye; Holmes, Randall, Rigby, Anderson, Rhule, Coy and Brandl, voting nay; Ewart, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Brandl, seconded by Anderson, that Mr. J. C. Westergard be granted permission to haul all freight from the depot for the City. Roll call resulted as follows: voting aye; Brandl, Randall, Rigby and Anderson, absent and not voting; Ewart, passing; Holmes, Rhule and Coy whereupon the Mayor ordered that this matter be held over until the next meeting of August 16<sup>th</sup>.
