

JUNE 21, 1929

The City Council met in regular session on the above date at the hour of 8:00 P.M.

There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, Harry H. Payne, City Clerk, and Councilmen Holmes, Randall, Rigby, Anderson, Rhule, Brandl and Ewart, absent; Coy, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

A report was given by the Finance Committee on the Garbage Contract matter, recommending that the contract be let to Mr. Luther Likes at the sum of \$400.00 per month. It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Brandl, that all garbage contract bids be rejected. Roll call voting aye; Rigby, Anderson, Rhule, Brandl, Ewart and Randall, voting nay; Holmes, absent and not voting; Coy, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Anderson, seconded by Randall, that the Clerk be instructed to call for new bids for the removal of garbage and also that the person making the successful bid would be required to look after the City Dump Grounds, this to be specified in the contract. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

A report given by the Finance Committee on the Auditing matter recommended that the Van Dusen Auditing Company be employed to audit the books of the City for two years, from May 1st, 1929, to May 1st, 1931, at the price of \$525.00 per annum, payable quarterly.

It was moved by Randall, seconded by Anderson, that the Van Dusen Company be employed as recommended by the Finance Committee. Roll call voting aye; Rhule, Holmes, Randall and Anderson, passing; Brandl and Rigby, voting nay; Ewart, absent and not voting; Coy, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

The following report was read:

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Brandl, that the report as given by the Finance Committee regarding the Bonds be accepted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The claim of Kenneth S. MacKenzie in the sum of \$250.00 was read and referred to the Finance Committee.

The claim of William Rogers in the sum of \$266.37 was read and referred to the Finance Committee.

At this time an ordinance entitled "RELATING TO THE PLANTING, PRUNING, GENERAL CARE AND SUPERVISION OF SHRUBS AND TREES GROWING IN THE PARKS AND PARKING AND ON OTHER LANDS CONTROLLED BY THE CITY OF IDAHO, FALLS, IDAHO" was presented and read, and it was moved by Holmes, seconded by Rhule, that the ordinance pass its first reading. Roll call voting aye; Brandl, Ewart, Holmes, Randall, Rigby, Anderson and Rhule, absent and not voting; Coy.

The following applications for building permits were read:

All of the above having been approved by the Building Inspector, it was moved by Ewart, seconded by Rhule, that the above permits be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

At this time the Mayor appointed C. S. Newby as Sexton of the cemetery. It was moved by Ewart that this appointment be confirmed, but the motion was lost for want of a second.

It was moved by Rigby, seconded by Ewart, that Al Heslop be confirmed as Sexton of the cemetery. Roll call voting aye; Rigby and Ewart, voting nay; Anderson, Rhule, Brandl, Holmes and Randall, absent and not voting; Coy, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion lost.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Randall, that Mr. Gould be appointed as Sexton of the cemetery. Roll call voting aye; Anderson, Rhule, Brandl, Ewart, Holmes, Randall and Rigby, absent and not voting; Coy, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Holmes, seconded by Anderson, that an ordinance be drawn creating and establishing a position to be known as Supervisor of Parks. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rigby, seconded by Anderson, that the sum of \$250.00 be allowed to the American Legion to police City on the 4th of July. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Rhule, that the report of the Band Committee be adopted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

At this time Mr. A. T. Shane addressed the Council regarding the paving of a certain street known as Legion Drive, but no action was taken by the Council.

The following applications for licenses were read:
