

MAY 31, 1929

The City Council met on the above date at the hour of 8:00 P.M. in special session pursuant to a recess taken at a special meeting on May 28, 1928. There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, Harry H. Payne, City Clerk, and the following Councilmen: Anderson, Rhule, Coy, Brandl, Ewart, Holmes, Randall and Rigby when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The purpose of this meeting was to open and consider bids presented for the furnishing of plumbing materials and heating plant needed for the new Fire Station Building.

The bids were opened and read by the Clerk as follows:

C. W. & M. Company	\$3,258.53
Geo. Tway & Company	2,905.00
A. A. Smith Company	2,836.88

It was recommended by the Building Committee, Councilmen Ewart, Coy and Brandl, that the bid of A. A. Smith be accepted.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Anderson, that the bid submitted by A. A. Smith Company to furnish all plumbing material and heating plant for the new Fire Station as stated in the call for bids in the total sum of \$2,836.88 be accepted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Randall, seconded by Coy, that the meeting do now adjourn. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
