

MAY 20, 1929

The City Council met in regular recess session on the above date at the hour of 8:00 p.m. pursuant to a recess taken on May 17, 1929. There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, Harry H. Payne, City Clerk, and Councilmen Anderson, Rhule, Coy, Brandl, Randall and Holmes, absent; Rigby and Ewart, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The Mayor then announced the following Police Department appointments:

For police patrolman, Frank Norton, and on motion of Randall, seconded by Coy, the appointment was confirmed unanimously.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Randall, that the appointment of H. Changnon as patrolman be confirmed. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Holmes, that the appointment of Wm. McCrary as patrolman be confirmed. Roll call voting aye; Coy, Brandl, Holmes, Randall and Rhule, voting nay; Anderson, absent and not voting; Ewart and Rigby, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Randall, that the appointment of Ray Hogue as patrolman be confirmed. Roll call voting aye; Holmes, Brandl, Anderson and Coy; voting nay; Randall and Rhule, absent and not voting; Ewart and Rigby, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Randall, seconded by Rhule, that the appointment of Ernest Harker as patrolman be confirmed. Roll call voting aye; Ewart, Holmes, Randall, Anderson, Rhule, Coy and Brandl, voting nay; none, absent and not voting; Ewart and Rigby, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Rhule, seconded by Holmes, that the appointment of Theodore Jackson as patrolman be confirmed. Roll call voting aye; Holmes, Randall, Rhule, Coy, voting nay; Anderson and Brandl, absent and not voting; Rigby and Ewart, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

At this time the following ordinance was then introduced by the Chamber of Commerce and the City Beautifying Committee and read in full by the Clerk "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PLANTING, PRUNING, GENERAL CARE AND SUPERVISION OF SHRUBS AND TREES GROWING IN THE PARKS AND PARKING AND ON OTHER LANDS CONTROLLED BY THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS", was referred to the Ordinance Committee.

At this time Councilmen Ewart and Rigby entered and thereafter participated in the Council proceedings.

The following applications for building permits were read:

The above having been approved by the Building Inspector, it was moved by Coy, seconded by Holmes, that the permits be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The report of the Police Judge, Douglas Hix, was read and ordered filed.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Rhule, that R. H. Snyder be re-appointed on the Library Board. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Ewart, that Mrs. Fred Moseley be re-appointed on the Library board. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The appointment of Bandmaster was referred to the Band Committee.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Brandl, that the City Clerk be instructed to advertise for bids for the removal of garbage from the City for the years of 1929 and 1930. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

At this time an ordinance entitled "BE IT ORDAINED THAT THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS THAT SECTION THREE OF ORDINANCE NO. 436 PROVIDING FOR THE BONDING OF ALL OFFICERS OF SAID CITY, BE AMENDED, AND THAT SECTION THREE BE REPEALED AND SUBSTITUTED BY A NEW SECTION THREE, AS AMENDED" and after the same had been read in full by the Clerk, it was moved by Coy, seconded by Randall, that the ordinance pass its first reading. Roll call voting aye; Holmes, Randall, Rigby, Rhule, Coy, Brandl and Ewart, voting nay; Anderson, absent and not voting; none, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Coy, seconded by Ewart, that the rule of law requiring an ordinance to be read and passed at three separate meetings of the City Council be suspended and that we proceed to pass and approve the above ordinance under the suspension of the rules. Roll call voting aye; Holmes, Randall, Rigby, Anderson, Rhule, Coy, Brandl and Ewart, voting nay; none, absent and not voting; none, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried, and the necessary three-fourth having voted in the affirmative the rules were declared suspended.

The Clerk again read the ordinance in full and it was moved by Randall, seconded by Coy, that the ordinance pass its second reading. Roll call voting aye; Ewart, Holmes, Randall, Rigby, Anderson, Rhule, Coy and Brandl, voting nay; none, absent and not voting; none, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

The Clerk again read the ordinance in full and it was moved by Ewart, seconded by Holmes, that the ordinance pass its third and final reading and be finally passed, adopted and approved. Roll call voting aye; Randall, Rhule, Coy, Brandl, Ewart and Holmes, voting nay; Rigby and Anderson, absent and not voting; none, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance duly passed and adopted.

The said ordinance was then numbered Ordinance No. 438 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, in the presence of the City Council, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Idaho Falls Post, the official paper of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho and having a general circulation therein.

It was moved by Holmes, seconded by Ewart, that the Bond of the City Treasurer in the amount of \$100,000.00 be returned for cancellation. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The claim of C. T. Edwards again the City of Idaho Falls in the sum of \$1.475.00 was read and same was referred to the Light and Water Committee.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Coy, that we do now adjourn. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
