The petition of Mrs. Lucinda Owen et al for the creation of a sewer district was read and referred to the Street and Ditch Committee and the City Engineer.

The petition of about 450 persons to have submitted to the voters at the coming City election the following question "Shall a tax not exceeding two mills be levied for a municipal band?" was presented and referred to the City Attorney.

Mr. F. L. Hansen reported certain unsanitary conditions on the Van Epps property on Whittier Avenue.

Joseph Morley appeared before the Council and requested that improvements on the municipal airport be started with the understanding that \$5,000.00 or near be spent for the next three years for this purpose. It was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Ewart, that this matter be referred to the Finance Committee and City Attorney for report on April 10, 1929. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

City Attorney Albaugh reported that the case of the Forman vs. City of Idaho Falls had been decided in favor of the plaintiff and the judgment entered in the amount of \$400.00. Mr. Albaugh recommended that the City accept the verdict and pay the judgment. It was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Shippen, that the City Clerk and Mayor be authorized to pay the above judgment of \$400.00 and costs. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Ewart, that the City Attorney be instructed to notify the owners of the land on which the accident occurred that resulted in the above suit to fill the ditch across the same within ten days and that if the same is not done, the Street Department shall fill the culvert on Curtis Avenue and close the ditch. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Holmes, seconded by Ewart, that we do now recess to Wednesday, April 10, 1929, at 7:30 p.m. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
