There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, Helen Rogers, acting City Clerk, and Councilmen Schwarz, Shattuck, Shippen, Driscoll, Ewart and Holmes, absent; Coy and Randall, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The matter of a health unit for the City of Idaho Falls and Bonneville County, the expense of which is to be borne equally by the Rockefeller Institute, U. S. Government, Bonneville County and the City of Idaho Falls. It is estimated that the total expense of such a health unit would be \$10,000.00 per year. It was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Ewart, that the Council approve the health unit plan and that \$2,500.00 be appropriated in the 1929 budget for the City's share in the same with the understanding that this plan shall cover all sanitary inspection of the City including the inspection of milk, water, etc. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The claim of the Independent Lumber Company and Carl A. Moore in the amount of \$4,000.00 for partial payment on account of concrete work at the new power plant was presented, and it was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Ewart, that the claim be allowed and warrant ordered drawn on the

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Waterworks fund in payment of same. Roll call voting aye; Holmes, Shattuck, Shippen, Driscoll and Ewart, voting nay; Schwarz, absent and not voting; Randall and Coy, whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Ewart, that we do now adjourn. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
