The City Council met in recess session on the above date at the hour of 7:30 p.m.

There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, E. R. Underhill, City Clerk, and Councilmen Schwarz, Shippen, Coy, Driscoll, Ewart, absent; Shattuck, Holmes and Randall when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The claim of Carl A. Moore and the Independent Lumber Company in the amount of \$4,000.00 assigned to the American National Bank was presented and considered but no action taken.

The claim of Stephenson Brothers in the amount of \$272.00 assigned to Anderson Bros. Bank was presented and it was moved by Shippen, seconded by Driscoll, that the claim be allowed and a warrant ordered drawn on the Waterworks fund in payment of the same. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The request of John J. Lake for water main extension to Lots 7 to 12 in Block 24, Highland Park was presented and referred to the Light and Water Committee.

A report of Herman Harms, dated March 23, 1929 covering water analysis of the water used in the City of Idaho Falls was read and ordered filed.

A letter of thanks from Mrs. J. H. Wilson was read and ordered filed.

It was moved by Schwarz, seconded by Driscoll, that the City Clerk be ordered to publish a notice of election for a general City election to be held in the City of Idaho Falls on April 23, 1929, and that the following deputy registrars and judges of election be designated to act for the said election:

A communication from the Independent Lumber & Coal Company was read and referred to the Light and Water Committee.

Mrs. J. E. Browning appeared before the Council requesting \$25.00 for the benefit of the flower show to be held during the summer of 1929. It was moved by Schwarz, seconded by Ewart, that the request be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

Mrs. Browning also requested that Central Park in Capital Hill Addition and the waterworks ground at 10<sup>th</sup> and Boulevard be cleaned up, and it was promised that the same would be done.

Councilman Schwarz reported on the line to the Edwards gravel pit that the line could be constructed at a cost of \$600.00 and recommended that the same be done. It was moved by Shippen, seconded by Ewart, that this matter be referred to the Finance Committee and the City Attorney. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Shippen, that we do now adjourn. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
