

MARCH 15, 1929

The City Council met in regular session on the above date at the hour of 8:00 p.m.

There were present; Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor, E. R. Underhill, City Clerk, and Councilmen Shippen, Coy, Driscoll, Ewart, Schwarz and Shattuck, absent; Holmes and Randall, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The claim of F. W. Woolworth Company in the amount of \$117.11 for damages by water was presented with the recommendation of the Finance Committee that the same be allowed in the amount of \$70.00. It was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Ewart, that the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and a warrant ordered drawn on the General Fund in full payment of the above claim in the amount of \$70.00. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

A report of the Department of Public Welfare on water analysis was read and ordered file.

The following applications for building permits were read:

All of the above having been approved by the Chief of Police and the Police Committee, it was moved by Schwarz, seconded by Driscoll, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

A communication from the Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference was read and referred to the Building Inspector.

C. T. Edwards appeared before the Council requesting a construction of a power line to his gravel pit on the highway south of the City. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Shippen, that this matter be referred to the Light and Water Committee and City Electrician with power to act. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Shippen, that C. P. Kirksey be allowed \$25.00 in full settlement of his claim against the City for loss of time at the new power plant, and the City Clerk be authorized to draw warrant in payment of the same against the Electric Light Fund. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Shattuck, that the name of R. H. Albers be stricken from the roll of the volunteer firemen from this date. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Schwarz, seconded by Driscoll, that a permanent watchman be employed for the new power plant. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The Mayor announced that the American Legion has requested permission to have the exclusive use of the Ball Park on July 4th, 1929. It was moved by Coy, seconded by Shippen, that the request be granted. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Shattuck, that the Fire Chief and City Engineer be instructed to have the fire hydrant at Park and A Street repaired or replaced so as to prevent further damage to the stock of the F. W. Woolworth Co. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

The report of C. B. Moon covering the quarter ending February 28, 1929, was presented and referred to the Finance Committee.

At this time Mr. Clarence Van Dusen appeared before the Council and submitted a proposition for a special audit of the City finances for the past two years. It was moved by Schwarz, seconded by Shippen, that this matter be referred to the Finance Committee with power to act. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.

It was moved by Shattuck, seconded by Ewart, that we do now recess to 7:30 p.m. March 25th, 1929. Roll call voting aye; unanimous.
