

NOVEMBER 8, 1993

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the City Council Chamber, 140 South Capital Avenue, Idaho Falls, Idaho, on Monday, November 8, 1993, at 4:00 O'clock P.M., for the purpose of canvassing all votes cast at the General Municipal Election held November 2, 1993, and to appoint a Mayor. There were present: Mayor ProTem Melvin L. Erickson; Councilmembers Linda Milam, Gary Mills, and Ralph Wood; Absent, Councilmembers Larry Carlson and Joseph Groberg. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale Storer, City Attorney; and Craig Lords, Municipal Services Director.

At the request of Mayor ProTem Erickson, the City Clerk reviewed the votes received by each candidate, noting there were no changes made from the accounting on November 2, 1993. The City Clerk noted that there were 25,569 registered, 12,638 persons voted for 49.4%. Notation was made that four voting precincts were incorrectly identified.

It was moved by Councilmember Erickson, seconded by Mills, that Linda Milam be appointed to fill the unexpired term of Mayor Thomas Campbell to be Mayor of the City of Idaho Falls from the time that she will be sworn in on November 19, 1993, until January 6, 1994, when she will be sworn in as Mayor for her elected term, also that Councilmember Ralph Wood be appointed as Mayor ProTem to act on City matters when Mayor ProTem Erickson is unavailable. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmembers Mills, Erickson, Wood, and Milam; No, none; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilmember Wood, seconded by Milam, that the Meeting adjourn at 4:45 P.M.; carried.
